

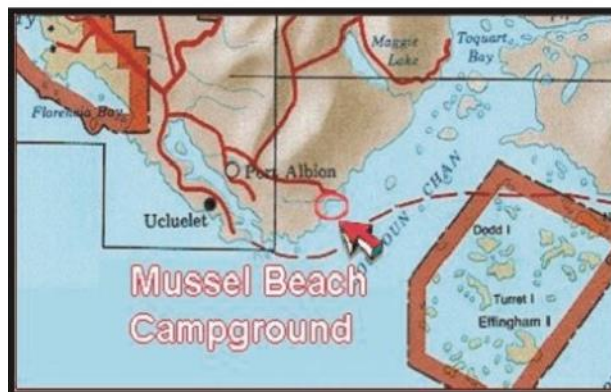


Beachcombing for Miles

Directions to Mussel Beach

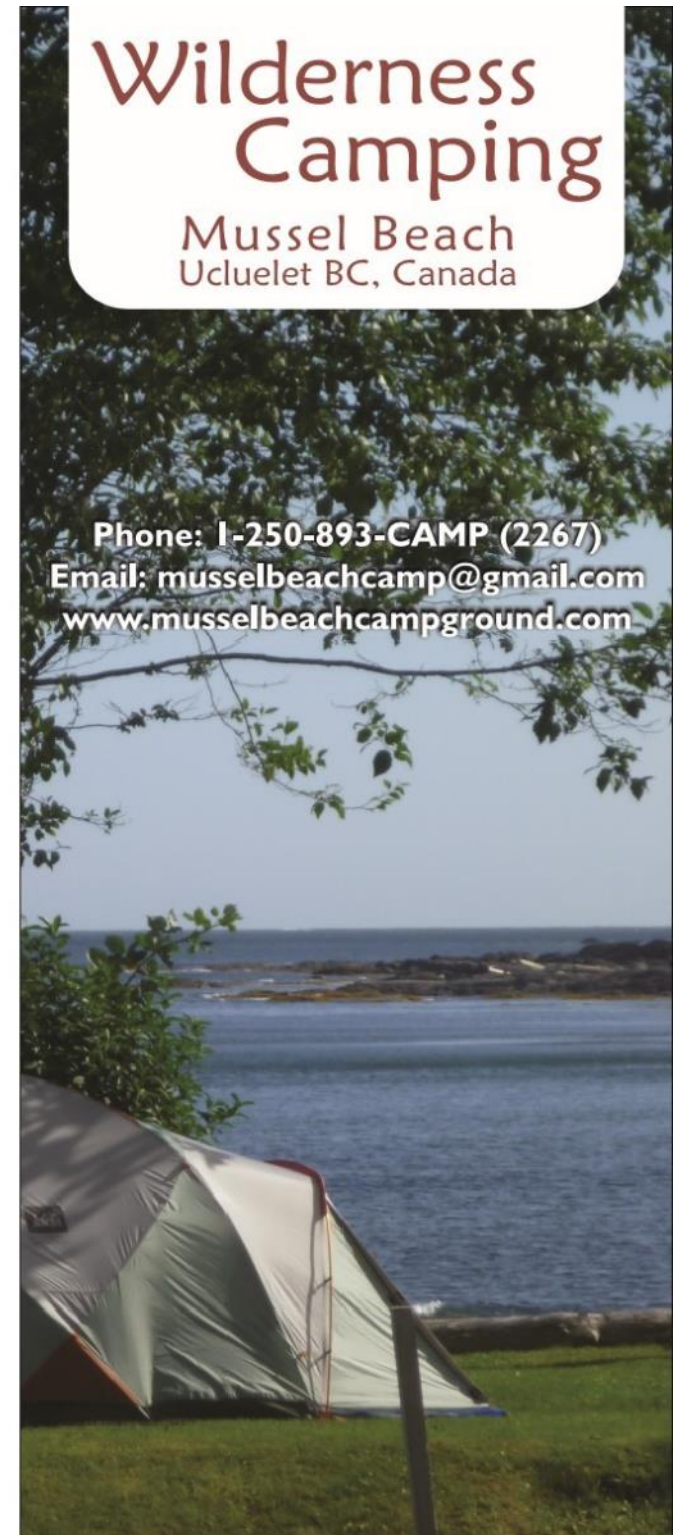
To get to Mussel Beach Wilderness Campground, follow the No. 4 Highway to the West Coast of Vancouver Island, B.C. Continue through Port Alberni and follow the signs to the Ucluelet/Tofino Pacific Rim area. Turn left at the Tofino/Ucluelet highway junction (junction 4), then turn left again at Port Albion Road. Mussel Beach is approximately a 20-minute drive over 5 km of paved road and 8 km of logging roads. Just follow the signs along the way!

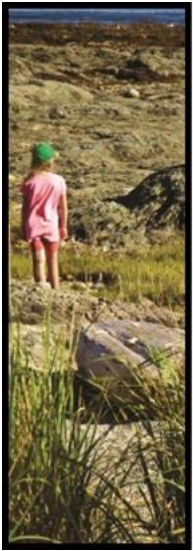
